Thank you all for venturing to the London borough of Havering to run around the eastern side of Hornchurch. We were fortunate with the weather after the torrential rain most of the day before. I decided to incorrporate the river Ingesbourne on both courses as it's a very distinct feature in the area and has some well-maintained paths.
