

Thank you all for coming along to run in Pitsea last night. Cold and crisp weather, that stayed dry. A little slippery underfoot in a couple of spots, but generally good running conditions.

Thanks to Chloe for setting an excellent course on a complex area - there were several sections with a high density of controls, but with numerous paths and cut throughs to keep you on your toes. An interesting twist with the four high scoring controls and all the rest worth the same, so there was a lot of different routes taken, and almost everyone got back in time - a couple of runners recording long times though - so hopefully there were no injuries.

The MapRun scoring systems do not cope well with that scoring, so I have manually adjusted everyone's score on the server to credit 10 points per control, 10 points per part minute late, and the four 40 point controls.
